WORKSHOP ON DEVELOPMENT OF A MASTER'S PROGRAMME IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION FOR THE ACADEMY OF CIVIL SERVICE UNDER THE PRESIDENT OF TURKMENISTAN (MPA WORKSHOPS)

Two-day workshop is organised by EU funded Project "Support for Public Administration Capacity Building in Turkmenistan" in Gala Cultural Centre. Project International and National Experts as well as project partners got together for the fifth round of the MPA workshops to present and discuss the works and achievements in Development of a Master's Program in Public Administration.

The workshop is aimed at enhancing the institutional and training capacities of the Academy of Civil Service under the President of Turkmenistan (AoSC) and other stakeholders through development of modern training programs.

Participants of the workshop are the representatives of AoSC and other stakeholders like Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Turkmenistan, Ministry of Finance and Economy of Turkmenistan, Ministry of Education of Turkmenistan, the Turkmen State University named after Magtymguly, International University for Humanities and Development, Institute of International Relations of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Turkmenistan.

The First day of the workshop started from brief presentation about MPA program by the Eduard Zakharchenko. Event covers important topics like Regulations on admission, practice and research work of the MPA program for AoCS presented by the project coordinator Babahan Berdiyev. Development of Skills for a High Performing Civil Service: Best Practices from the OECD countries is presented by the Harry List. Active day will be ended with questions and discussions.

The second day will continue with presentation of Mr. List about HRM curriculum and allocation of ECTS to subtopics. Economic curriculum and allocation of ECTS to subtopics will be presented by the Axel Koetz. Tavus Mollayeva will present specific aspects of Administrative Procedure Curriculum, taking into account international practice.

MPA workshops, organized within the framework of the EU funded Project serve as a platform to successful development and implementation of MPA program for AoCS and will further support the Academy in developing its potential.
